




The Workshop

Masterpiece Rocking Horses stand out from the other brands because they are completely hand made by Sporting Artist Teresa Davis, each horse is totally unique no two are alike. They are completely hand carved using traditional methods, a slow process which only allows Teresa to make a couple horses a year. This makes them very collectable and rare.

Nested at the foot of the Quantock Hlils in Somerset, Teresas studio/workshop is a fantastic place to visit. It has a wonderful gallery full of Art Work and Rocking Horses.









My Story

Masterpiece Rocking Horses is the creation of renowned sporting Artist Teresa Davis.

Although Teresa is kept very busy with her oil paintings, transforming and making Rocking Horses is a hobby that fast became part of her Sporting Art business and has now branched out into an artisan business of its own.

As an artist she specialises in British wildlife and Sporting subjects, Horse Racing and Foxhunting featuring prominently as subjects. Working mainly in oils and pastels her work can be found in collections around the world. Growing up around horses, they have been a life long passion and inspiration for much of conformation of them like the back of her hand which is incredibly helpful when making her creations look real. Without doubt the 20 years experience producing oil paintings of horses has led to the paintwork on the Rocking Horses being a piece of art all in itself.













Dancer

Dancer is a stunning Dapple Grey Thoroughbred. He has been hand carved and painted by Teresa.

Dancer comes with fully removable tack hand stitched in superb high quality English leather and solid brass buckles.

He stands at 120 cm from floor to top of head and his stand is 141cm long

His mane and tail is real horse hair.

He can be ridden by children and small adults alike
We recommend adult supervision when children are riding.

Made to measure rugs can be purchased separately and bespoke browbands can be made in a choice of colours

Handmade Tack



Designed and hand stitched by Teresa using English Sedgwick bridle butt beautifully oak stained dark havana. This leather tack is good enough to use on a real horse! brow bands can de ordered in plain leather of in sharks teeth velvet ribbon, with your choice of colour.

Each bridle is made to measure your horse exactly.

Buckles are made from solid cast Brass.









Hand Carving





Teresa loves to use traditional hand tools when carving, every horse she produces will be different, each with its own character and personality, these horses truly are completely hand crafted.

There is nothing like the sound and feel of the hammer and chisel on wood, An age old craft which Teresa uses. Her knowledge of horses and artistic eye are instrumental in achieving the life like and accurate portrayal of the horses conformation.

















Finishing Touches



The finishing touches are truly what makes the horse complete, with over

25 years experience as a Sporting Artist there is no one better qualified than Teresa to paint Rocking Horses! She uses both Oil and Acrylic paints but tends to prefer Oil as it give such a rich depth of colour, they are then covered with a very robust varnish to protect them,

The super high quality glass eyes really bring the horse to life.

The final job is to attach the real horse hair mane and tail, these hides are hand persevered by Teresa here at the studio.
